OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

In view of the data on the ecological flow of the Lérez river, from which the Pontevedra biomill is supplied, last Wednesday July 20, the Company decided to begin the temporary suspension of the biomill's activity.

With the information currently available, it is not possible to determine the duration of this situation and the effect it will have on the production of the biomill.

However, it should be noted that the Company estimates that the situation would have to continue for more than one month before it could have a material impact on the results for the year.

In the semi-annual information that will be published on July 26, the Company will expand on any additional information that may be available in this regard.

Ence Group has two eucalyptus hardwood pulp biomills in north-western Spain: a 685,000-tonne-capacity biomill located in Navia, Asturias, and a 515,000-tonne-capacity biomill located in Pontevedra, Galicia. In addition, it is the largest generator of renewable energy with agricultural and forestry biomass in Spain and has eight plants currently in operation with a combined installed capacity of 266 MW.
