

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 17 of Regulation (EU) 596/2014 of 16 April 2014 on Market Abuse (Market Abuse Regulation) and Article 228 of the Securities Market Act, **Ence Energía y Celulosa, S.A.** ("**Ence**") hereby notifies the following:

RELEVANT EVENT

Further to the notification of the relevant event no. 261836 published today in relation to the the launching of the issue by Ence of bonds convertible into new or existing ordinary shares of Ence (the "**Shares**") for a principal amount of €160 million (the "**Bonds**"), excluding the preferred subscription right held by the shareholders (the "**Issue**"), upon completion of the bookbuilding process carried out today by BNP Paribas acting as Sole Global Coordinator and Sole Bookrunner, Ence has finalised the main terms and conditions of the Bonds with the exception of the initial conversion price of the Bonds which will be determined upon closing of trading today.

New Issue of Bonds

- a. The aggregate principal amount of the Bonds will be ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY MILLION EUROS (€160,000,000).
- b. The Bonds will bear a nominal annual fixed interest of 1.25% payable semi-annually in arrear on the 5 March and 5 September of each year, with the first interest payment date being 5 September 2018.
- c. The Bonds will be convertible at the option of bondholders into Shares at an initial conversion price set at a premium of 40% above the volume-weighted average price (VWAP) of the Shares on the Spanish Stock Exchanges between opening and closing of trading today. The exact initial conversion price will be confirmed and communicated after closing of trading today. Upon conversion, Ence will have the option to deliver new or existing Shares or a combination thereof. The conversion price will be subject to customary adjustment provisions set out in the terms and conditions of the Bonds.

Ence has signed today with BNP Paribas the subscription agreement in relation to the Bonds (the "**Subscription Agreement**").

The subscription and payment for the Bonds is expected to take place on 5 March 2018 (the "**Issue Date**"), provided that the applicable conditions established in the Subscription Agreement are fulfilled.
